### **NEW KLIPRIVER RESERVOIR ENCOURAGES ECONOMIC GROWTH IN MIDVAAL**

Today the Executive Mayor of Midvaal Municipality Cllr Timothy Nast officially opened the Klipriver Reservoir. This R32 million project forms part of the bulk water supply for the Klipriver Development Node which includes the Klipriver Business Park and Sedibeng Brewery.

The project was financed by Sedibeng Breweries and City Square under the Municipal Bulk Services Contribution Policy. The reservoir's project commenced in November 2008 and was completed recently in October 2010. This project met the tight water supply programme of Sedibeng Breweries and water was available on schedule at the end of April 2009.

"The Klipriver Reservoir is another example of how Midvaal and the developers are working hand in hand to provide better infrastructure to the community. It is also proof that the area has maintained its position as the most important growth point in Gauteng," says Mayor Nast.

The entire community of Midvaal is set to benefit as this project brings both capital investment and creation of job opportunities with it. This highlights the exciting economic development taking place in the Midvaal area. In the future the reservoir will supply water to newly planned residential developments in the area.
