JACK BLOOM VISITS MIDVAAL CLINIC

The DA Spokesperson on Health in Gauteng, Mr. Jack Bloom, visited the state of the art community clinic in Meyerton, South of Johannesburg on an oversight visit today.

Midvaal Local Municipality prides itself on the facility that services an average of 30 000 people with a turnaround time of two hours per patient, even though the norms and standards for Gauteng clinics is three hours.

Mr. Bloom undertook to assist Midvaal by taking up the issue of the HIV/AIDS grant cancellation which affects community workers, with the Gauteng Provincial Legislature.

Commenting that he has been to many clinics, Mr Bloom said he was impressed with the facility, particularly the atmosphere and turnaround time. He felt that the Midvaal clinic could serve as an example to clinics in Gauteng as they continually strive to exceed expectations when serving the community.
