Kindly Note:

- Nominations of candidates for Ward Committee as well as Sector declaration forms must be collected from the Ward Councillor or the Speaker's Office, and returned to the Speaker's Office at Cnr, Mitchell and Junius Street, Meyerton, before the closing date on 02 September 2016.
- The standard agenda indicated will be the only business of the meeting.
- Objection forms will be available post elections at respective voting venues.
- Priority Sectors are: 1. Engineering (Roads, water, sewer, electrical); 2. Social Services (Parks, refuse, clinics, culture, ECD, drugs, etc); 3. Development and Planning (and Housing); 4. Finance & Council affairs & HR ; 5. Protection Services, disaster management & CPF; 6. Women; 7. Youth; 8. Disabled; 9. Community based organisations (NGOs, NPOs, etc); 10. Other for a ward - specific purpose
- A 50/50 gender representation policy is applicable.
- A Ward Committee is composed of no more than 10 members excluding the Ward Councillor who is the Chairperson.
- No less than two (2) nominations per sector is allowed for the elections.
- Only residents whose names appear on the Ward Voters Roll of the applicable segment and are in possession of a South African green bar-coded ID/ smart card will be eligible to participate in the election process.
- Council Officials are strictly prohibited from participation in the elections.
- The Midvaal Local Municipality and its Ward Arbitration Committee uphold discretion over all Ward Committee related matters.
- The elections will be conducted by the local Independent Electoral Commission Office.

What you should know about your Ward Councillor and Ward Committee:

- * The Ward Committee serves a 5-year term of Office as per Council Resolution.
- * The Ward Committee officially meets four times in a cycle of twelve (12) months. In addition, public meetings as well as State of the Municipality Address are held in the same cycle.
- * Ward Committee members serve on voluntary basis and no remuneration is payable for services of the Committee. However, only a stipend known as the "out-of-pocket expense" is payable as determined by Council.
- * Ward Committee members are expected to assist the Ward Councillor in identifying priority needs of the Ward as well as community based planning, thus ensuring service delivery and development in the Ward.
