Electricity Distribution Services Feasibility Study Report: Invitation to Public Meeting and Comments

In terms of the provisions of Section 120(6)(b) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, No. 56 of 2003, Midvaal Local Municipality hereby makes known that it has completed a review of a feasibility study focused on entering into a Public-Private Partnership for the management, operation and maintenance of the electricity distribution services in Midvaal. The feasibility study was originally completed in May 2018 and took into consideration the comments received from the community during consultation meetings for residents and business held in January 2018. With the appointment of a new transaction advisory team in June 2019 with project development funding obtained from the Infrastructure Investment Programme for South Africa (IIPSA), a review of the originally study was undertaken. The public was duly informed thereof as per public notices on 13 August 2019 in the Sedibeng Ster and on 14 August 2019 in the North Ster including Vaalweekblad Online.

The review of the Feasibility Study Report was done in accordance with a Council decision and completed in compliance with all relevant and prescribed legislation.

Members of the community and other interested and affected persons are invited to a public meeting to be held at 18h00 on 3 December 2019 in the Mayoral Activity Room , Midvaal Local Municipal Offices, 25 Mitchell Street, Meyerton. The meeting aims to inform the community of the reasons and purpose of the feasibility study and to obtain the community's input. It be noted that only areas supplied by Midvaal Local Municipality will be affected. (Eskom areas are excluded).

As from 10 December 2019 the Feasibility Study Report will also be available for inspection at the Municipality's offices and libraries during the official hours of operation of these offices and libraries and it will be available on the Municipality's official website www.midvaal.gov.za. Members of the community and other interested persons are invited to submit to the Municipality their comments in respect of the Feasibility Study Report on or before **10** February 2020.
