



### **Urgent Notice - Provincial Road Repairs Jim Fouche / Boundary Road**

The Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport has earmarked Boundary Road (D878) also known as Jim Fouche Road which is a provincial road, for urgent repair and maintenance. Construction on this provincial road has been initiated due to the safety hazard posed by the instability of the western end bridge.

- The duration of the 5 week procurement phase commences on 03 February 2014,
- The construction phase which starts on 10 March 2014, is anticipated to continue for a further 3 months.

The following measures will be implemented progressively as required:

- Speed humps will be erected in both directions before the bridge,
- Speed limit will be reduced to 30km/h,
- Only light motor vehicles will be allowed to cross the Boundary Road bridge, between Verwoerd Road and Langenhoven Street,
- Motor vehicles weighing 3 tons and above [including buses] need to consider alternative routes as no access will be allowed to such vehicles.
- One lane will be closed,
- Stop and go will be applicable,
- Traffic Officers will assist during peak hours from:
  - 06:45 to 09:00
  - 15:30 to 18:00
- The Provincial Roads Department will provide assistance from 09:00 to 15:30.

We urge residents to be patient and co-operative during the maintenance period, as the final result will be a safer road for all.
