- Noted, the 2026-2027 IDP review will incorporate G13 priorities.

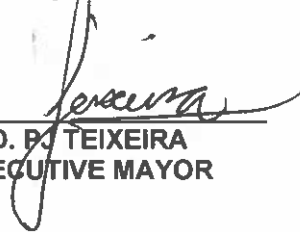
3. Participation in the National Strategic Hub

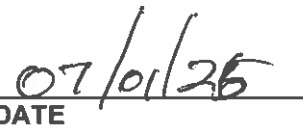
- Noted, the municipality participates in sessions as and when invitations are received.
